Worship

-A moment-by-moment expression of gratitude, honor, and glory to our creator and savior. Worship essentially defines the passion of Water's Edge. When Jesus is treasured above all things life itself becomes a continual act of worship (Col. 1:23, Jn. 4:23-24).

Fellowship

-The joining together of hearts and lives for the unified purpose of encouraging one another in Christ and working together to see the advancement of the Kingdom of God (Heb. 10:23-25).

Discipleship

-The teaching and learning of God's truths revealed in Scripture for the purpose of knowing and loving God more (2 Tim. 3:14-17; Heb. 6:1).

Service

-Recognizing and taking action to meet the needs of the Water's Edge Family and those in Lake Country and beyond, both spiritually and physically (1 Jn. 3:17-18).

Missions

-Proclaiming the glory of God to all people groups of Lake Country and beyond (world). Salvation in Jesus Christ (so that one may come to worship, glorify, and treasure Him above all else) is the greatest need of mankind (2 Cor. 5:17-21; Matt. 28:18-20).

Administration

-Facilitating, coordinating, and encouraging working relationships and providing resources to ministry teams for the building up of the church and the expansion of God's kingdom (Eph. 4:12; 2:22; 1 Cor. 12:28).
